Here is an overview of tasks I'd like the children to complete at home over the forthcoming weeks. It is important that they complete a test from their ten minute test books daily.

Booster books

For those children who have been attending booster, completing more pages in the CGP maths or reading books will be good practise.

Reading Comprehension

10 Minute CGP Test Book:

Any uncompleted tests will be good practise in book 1 and book 2.

Maths

10 Minute CGP Test Book:

Children have been given book 1 and book 2. Work through this daily.

Daily Arithmetic:

The website www.myminimaths.co.uk has a section named year 6 arithmetic practise papers which gives 8 daily questions.

Problem solving

The website

has a huge number of sheets which can be printed off or looked at online with a range of problem solving questions. There are 4 different levels. I suggest gold level for practice at year 6 expected standard.

MyMaths

I have set 10 tasks, revising the learning we have covered this term. Children can complete a task a day.

10 Minute CGP Test Book:

Children have book 1 and book 2. Work through this daily.

Science: Properties of Materials!

Our Science topic after Easter will be 'Properties of Materials'. Can you make any reversible / irreversible changes in your kitchen involving cooking? OR look at objects in your house and record their properties. Are they strong, flexible, rough, smooth?

Our science topic this term has been Earth and Space. Children could research who first walked on the moon. They could write a biography of one of the astronauts or a recount of the event itself.
