Please find a list of work which will need to be completed whilst your children are at home. .

Project based homework:

Choose from Science and/or History.

Children can present their topic work however they chose.

This could include making a model, PowerPoint, Art, research, poetry, research page, travel brochure.

Science: Living things and their habitats

-Explain how animals get their food from plants and animals using a simple food chain.

-Explain that most living things live in habitats which suit them and depend on each other.

Other ideas: Create a mobile using a coat hanger, pictures and descriptions,

History: Changes in living memory

Seaside holidays through the ages (Holiday focus- UK holiday resorts to now being able to go abroad).

How have holidays changed? What is still the same? Refer to human and physical features and changes in transport.

- Story Writing:
- Read a story you have at home.
 - Re-write the story using "and" to link sentences. (Y1)
 - Re-write the story using "for, and, but, or, yet, so" (Y2)
- Draw a picture of the story.

Instructions: -Write a set of instructions on how to complete an activity.

For example how to make a jam sandwich, clean your teeth, make fairy cakes.

Include the following:

-Time conjunctions (first, then, next, later, after a while)

-Instructions in sequential order.

-What you need section.

-Diagrams

-Look, say, cover, write, check. (Look at the word, say the word, cover the word, write the word and check).

-Writing spellings in sentences.

-Writing sentences using pyramids.

-Writing spellings in different colours- rainbow writing.
