Introduction

School uniform plays a role in contributing to the ethos of a school and setting an appropriate tone. A school uniform helps instil pride; support positive behaviour and discipline; encourage identity with, and support for, school ethos and protects children from social pressures to dress in a particular way.

The school recognises that it is the duty of parents / carers to ensure their child comes to school appropriately dressed in the school uniform.

School uniform (all to be named)

PE Kit – all children (all to be named)

PE Kit – Black shorts, yellow logo t-shirt, grey school hoody, and suitable shoes for outside games. Black tracksuit bottoms are acceptable in winter periods when outside. Hair if long is to be tied back.

Jewellery

The only jewellery permitted is one pair of stud ear-rings, to be removed or taped for P.E. These are the responsibility of the child. Watches may be worn (to be removed for P.E.) Nail varnish and make up are not permitted.
